


WILL of Mrs. Grace Ensor Brown (Mrs. W. S. Brown)   
Dated June 10, 1937.

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

I, Grace E. Brown, do make this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any former Wills by me made, that is to say:

Item 1: I desire all of my just debts and my funeral expenses to be first paid out of my estate.

Item 2: Should I die before my husband, William S. Brown, I will and bequeath to him all of my books and bookcases for his own personal use, to be disposed of as in his judgment seems good and proper. Should I outlive him, I will and bequeath to the Richland County Public Library all of my books and bookcases, provided the books are put and kept in a separate alcove or room connected with and a part of the Library, the alcove or room to be known, designated and marked "The W. S. Brown" alcove or room.

Item 3: Should I die before my said husband, I will, devise and bequeath to him for and during the term of his natural life, the use of all my property, real personal or mixed, of every kind, for the purpose of providing maintenance and a home with its comforts for him during his said life. My husband, W. S. Brown, is authorized to use any or all of the corpus of my property if it be necessary to provided for his own necessities and comfort.

Item 4: The Trustees named hereinbelow are directed out of the corpus of my estate to set aside a sum not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, and to utilize the interest and income therefrom in keeping in good order the lot in Elmwood Cemetery, in which my family is buried and in which my husband and I will be buried. The Trustees are authorized, if they deem it wise, to pay over to the Elmwood Cemetery Company, or its successors, a sum not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for perpetual care of this lot.

Item 5: After the death of my husband, should he survive me, or should he not survive me at the time of my death, I will, bequeath, devise and appoint to the Trustees hereinbelow named, and to their successors in office, all of my estate, real, personal, or mixed, to which I am legally or equitably entitled, or over which I may have any power of appointment, in trust, nevertheless, for the uses and purposes set out hereinbelow. Immediately upon the death of the life tenant, I desire the Trustees named hereinbelow to take over all of my properties, real and personal, for the purposes set out herein.

Item 6: This Board of Trustees shall consist of three persons, and shall originally be constituted as follows: Dr. C. Fred Williams, Mr. Gustaf J. Sylvan and Mrs. Christie Benet. This Board shall be a self perpetuating Board, and in case of a vacancy for any reason whatsoever, the remaining members of the Board shall name a successor to act with them under the trust set out herein; and this right to complete the membership of the Board shall remain with the Trustees, and shall be exercised by those who are Trustees at the time the vacancy occurs.

This Board of Trustees shall have the power, if in their discretion it is to the interest of the trust, at any time to name a corporate trustee to act in their stead or to act as one of the members of the Board along with the remaining Trustees. In case a corporate Trustee is named to act instead of a Board of three men, as provided herein, the said corporate trustee shall take this trust upon the terms set out herein.

Wherever the term Board of Trustees is used in this Will it shall be deemed to include its successors in office and deemed to include a Corporate Trustee, if one is named pursuant to the provisions set out herein, if such a meaning is permitted by the context.

The Board of Trustees shall hold, manage, control, exchange, invest and reinvest the properties bequeathed and devised herein, and the proceeds of those properties, and are expressly given the power to invest these properties and moneys in any form of investment which in their judgment constitutes a wise and sound investment, including the right to keep the investment in its present form, or to sell or realize on any or all of the present investments and to reinvest the same in real property, first mortgages, on real estate, in corporate, municipal, State or Federal bonds, in sound preferred or common stocks, or in such other way as may in their judgment be wise.

Item 7: The income from these properties shall be turned over by the Trustees to the Board of Regents of the South Carolina State Hospital at such time or times as the Trustees may deem wise. This income shall be used by the Board of Regents of the South Carolina State Hospital for the establishment and operation of a research laboratory to be known and designated as the Ensor Research Foundation, as a memorial to my father, Joshua Alton Ensor, M. D., at one time Superintendent of the South Carolina State Hospital, and his wife, Henrietta Kemp Ensor, established by their daughters, Annie J. L. Ensor and Grace Greenwood Ensor Brown.

The Board of Regents of the South Carolina State Hospital is requested to suitably mark their research department as a memorial to my father, Joshua Alton Ensor, M. D., and his wife, Henrietta Kemp Ensor, and to hang at a suitable place at the institution the portraits of my father and mother which my Trustees are directed to turn over to the Board of Regents of the South Carolina State Hospital.

The Trustees are also authorized and directed to deliver over to the Board of Regents of the South Carolina State Hospital such of the furniture and personal effects of my estate as may be suitable for use in connection with this research foundation. If in the opinion of my Trustees it is desirable for any reason to accumulate the income from this foundation they are authorized to withhold the income for such period as they deem wise and to add the same to the corpus of my estate.

ITEM 8: This trust shall be known as the Ensor Research Foundation. The Board of Trustees is authorized and empowered to receive bequests, devises or gifts from any other person or source to be added to the corpus of this fund for the purposes set out herein; and the Board of Regents of the South Carolina State Hospital is authorized to use such of the income from this trust as may be turned over to it by my Trustees in conjunction with any other funds which may be available for the same purposes.

ITEM 9: I hereby make, constitute and appoint my husband, William S. Brown, sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, with directions that he shall not be required to give bond.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 10th day of June, A.D. 1937.
