Component: Structured Living Unit

Goal: To evaluate all patients receiving neuroleptic medications in the unit by use of the Abnormal Involuntary Movement Scale (AIMS).

Status: All unit Physicians and Family Nurse Practitioners were trained in the use of the AIMS. Patients are currently being assessed.

Goal: Provide in-service training to staff of the Structured Living Program.

Status: All clinical staff has been involved in ongoing in-service training. This training has included discipline specific topics as well as presentations to unit-wide staff.

Component: Management Unit

Goal: Staff involvement in more therapies/activities.

Status: The Psychology staff complement has been doubled, involving creation of a central lab in the unit where a full program of group activities is conducted. Social Work and Licensed Nursing staff have signficantly increased their number of group treatment referrals.

Goal: Implement the case manager model for treatment team review.

Status: The case manager system is fully operational with regard to the ward-wide behavioral point program.

Component: Forensic Unit

Goal: Complete renovation of the Cooper Building.

Status: Renovation of the building was 90% completed.

Goal: Expand therapeutic programs for all forensic cases who are admitted as treatment cases and all who are retained for treatment.

Status: The addition of staff members in Psychology and Social Work has enabled the unit to offer a new comprehensive non-medical treatment program. The regular services of a chaplain have been secured for the units, and the Activity Therapy staff has been able to provide more efficient programming following consolidation of the unit.
