Dr. Sol Brown McLendon was born in Marlboro County, South Carolina. After graduating from the Bennettes ville High School he entered the Presbyterian College, Clinton, S. C., in 1921 and graduated in 1925, receiving the Bachelor of Arts Degree.

The same year he entered the College of Charleston, S. C., for one year's premedical work.

His Medical Degree was received from the Medical College of South Carolina, Charleston, in 1930.

On July 1, 1930, he joined the medical staft of the South Carolina State Hospital and he has been connected with the hospital continuously since that time.

At present Dr. McLendon is Clinical Director of the State Park Division, and Acting Clinical Director of the Columbia Division.
